ARIZONA LIVESCAN POINTS TO LACK OF GOVERNMENTAL OVERSIGHT FOR POOR QUALITY FINGERPRINTING

Arizona Livescan responds to those
whose fingerprints were rejected with free digital reprint program

PHOENIX, AZ-August 14, 2012 – Arizona Livescan points the finger at a lack of governmental oversight of fingerprint rollers who are neither licensed, registered nor certified by the State, but can offer the service anyway, and do so using error-prone ink pads. Arizona Livescan is the only private fingerprinting agency in Phoenix using state-of-the-art livescan technology that validates each fingerprint, ensuring prints are legible and classifiable.

As reported in the Arizona Republic, an alarming 7,000 fingerprint cards were rejected in the past three months by the Fingerprint Clearance Card Unit for quality issues ([DPS Struggles to OK wave of teacher fingerprints](#), 08/09/12). “As more applicants are introduced to our computerized fingerprinting services, we will minimize rejection rates and help applicants avoid delays in their application process.” says CEO and Founder, Paula Wilson, referring to the Arizona state-issued Fingerprint Clearance Card.

As a commitment to the community, Arizona Livescan offers free fingerprinting to anyone who has had their fingerprints rejected due to poor quality. “To qualify for the free digital reprint program, we require only that you submit your original receipt for fingerprinting service from a Maricopa County based law enforcement agency or business who provides public fingerprinting, and a copy of your rejection notice,” says Wilson.

“In Arizona, your barber and beautician is licensed, but the person rolling your fingerprints, who has access to your name, residence, social security number, date and place of birth is not.” states Wilson. “Until any type of regulation exists for our industry, Arizona Livescan will continue to set the standards with its FBI-certified equipment, TSA-Certification, and background-checked employees who are also Notaries Public well versed in identity verification.”
